- **Adult Theatre Arts Week – July 2 to 5**

DETAILS

Camps take place in the Stratford Normal School (270 Water St.) on the corner of Queen and Water in Stratford and run from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. each day.

Coffee and lunch are included each day. Each camp includes a ticket to a Stratford Festival performance as part of the programming.

Adult Theatre Arts Weekend: June 8 & 9

Meet with fellow Shakespeare lovers to explore the foundations of classical performance. Each day will focus on a different element of Shakespearean theatre and will include masterclasses with Festival artists. Includes a ticket to the 8pm performance of *The Merry Wives of Windsor* on June 8.

Participants will work with a variety of Festival teaching artists and coaches. Sessions will include a focus on voice and text, performance, scene study and physical theatre

Adult Theatre Arts Week: July 2 to 5

Meet with fellow Shakespeare lovers to explore voice, text, movement and performance. Each day will focus on a different element of classical theatre and will include masterclasses with Festival artists. Through guided exercises, scene study and rehearsal, participants will learn and stage selected scenes from one of Shakespeare's classics. Includes a ticket to the 2 pm matinée of *Othello* on July 4. This camp culminates with a showcase of selected scenes for family and friends.

Participants will work with a variety of Festival teaching artists and coaches. Sessions will include a focus on voice and text, performance, scene study and physical theatre as well as rehearsal for the final showcase.

INSTRUCTION

All of our programs are taught by theatre professionals with teaching experience who create dynamic programming for all ages.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Are meals included?

Coffee and lunch are included each day. Participants are responsible for all other meals.

Are accommodations included?

No, participants are responsible for their own accommodations.

Do you have to have theatre experience to participate?

None of our camps require previous experience or an audition for acceptance. All of our camps are interest-based; they are for anyone who is interested in learning and open to exploring the creative process with a community of peers.
