Designed for families of all ages, the weekend provides an introduction to all the Festival has to offer. It comprises a series of active workshops, including stage combat, choreography and performance, plus a backstage tour for everyone and a special hands-on prop-building workshop just for the kids.

### DETAILS

Camps take place in the Stratford Normal School (270 Water St.) on the corner of Queen and Water in Stratford and run from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. each day.

Coffee and lunch are included each day. The camp includes a ticket to the 2 pm matinée of *Billy Elliot the Musical* on July 6.
